

Write up on efforts made in the field of environmental education, sports achievements, Innovations, overall results, PTA activities, important SMC Decisions added in the annual report of the school

We entered the 2nd Academic year with the same set of challenges and opportunities brought by Covid19 as it continued without any end in view and the schools could not conduct physical classes. Meantime it opened an opportunity to explore various options available in digital platforms. The teachers prepared customized digital content and shared the same with the students concerned. Online tests were conducted at regular intervals to assess the competency level of the students. The reports cards were generated and shared with the parents. Our tech support and teachers were instrumental in reaching out to the students of rural areas effectively and safely through a school app with exclusive access to the students of our school.

53 students appeared for Parichaya Examination conducted by the Dakshina Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha. 49 students secured 60% and above and 3 students scored 50% and above. Ms. Kaviya Ilakiya won a cash award of Rs. 7500 in the painting competition on Energy Conservation, 2021, and brought laurels to the school. Our student G.S.Tamizhselvam of Grade 2 has won second prize in District Level Chess Competition conducted recently.

The school organized competitions both online and offline to mark various national, religious and seasonal festivals of India to spread awareness and kindle the creativity of the students

The school created a vegetable garden during the pandemic period and upgraded the ambiance in terms of planting more saplings around the school campus.

A group of doctors from Aaruppadai Veedu Medical College and Hospital, comprising of specialists in the areas of Dentistry, ENT, Ophthalmology, Dermatology, and General Medicine visited our school with a team of nurses from the same hospital on 21st December 2021 and examined the students. They made a few recommendations to the students to improve their lives and keep their body and mind healthy.

As our motto is "Value Building is Nation Building". We inculcate in our students the spirit of sharing our resources with the needy ones. The students of our school have donated provisions such as rice, dal, sweets, stationaries like a pen, pencil, paper, etc worth about Rs.50000 (Rs. Fifty thousand) to Baby Sarah's Home (Integrated Rehabilitation and Development Centre Registered and Recognized by state and Central Govt).

There were both virtual and physical parent-teacher's meetings held during this academic year 2021-22 to get the feedback of the parents on academic-related issues and the quality of online and offline classes conducted. The parents appreciated the efforts of the teachers and thanked them.

SMC was convened twice in this academic year to discuss expansion plans and ways and means of increasing the number of students enrolled in the school. Minutes are duly recorded and filed.
