

MVM Pondy is happy to be able to continue the good work initiated by sending worksheets to the students through WhatsApp. The worksheets enable the students to think and analyze the concepts better. The teachers have received the answer scripts from the students and have made the corrections till date. We have been giving the students content for classwork note books and a few additional worksheets for self-evaluation of understanding of the concepts taught through online classes.

ONLINE CLASSES

Number of sessions has been increased for Grade III to Grade VII keeping the time limit allowed by the Government guidelines. Within the available time, art, music and physical education classes are also conducted so that both curricular and cocurricular activities are reaching the students. We use MS Teams app with high Audio and Video quality.

Augmented reality is used to enhance natural environments or situations and offer perceptually enriched experiences to the students. It is like adding an extra layer onto your physical surroundings. That layer could be an animation, a 3D model, or any combination of images, sound, and video that together create an immersive experience. Augmented Reality videos on animals, reptiles, solar system, vehicles etc. have been shot with our primary teachers and shared with the children of Pre-K. G. to Grade II.







Academics OBTA

The Central Board of Secondary Education recommends that multiple modes of assessment need to be provided to cater to the varied abilities of individual strengths of learners. Open Text Book Assessment was conducted for the students of Grade I to Grade VII based on core subjects. A textual material in the form of an article, a case study, a diagram, a concept/ mind map, a picture or a cartoon, problem/situation based on the concepts taught to the students is shared with a set of questions based on it. The Open Text based Assessment (OTBA) carries questions of higher order thinking skills, some of which may be subjective, creative, open ended and value based. Using the materials, the students have to find out the answers to the questions. The students' performance in the recently concluded assessment is found to be satisfactory.

ONLINE TEST

Online test – II was conducted for Grade I - Grade VII. Test was for a maximum of 50 marks. Timing for each session was 75 minutes. The students were eager to take up the tests and get instant scores. The questions were framed to kindle the curiosity of the students. The parents appreciated the efforts put in by the school. They also gave a few suggestions for improvement. All the students attended the test and report cards were shared individually to the parents through private WhatsApp number.





NOTE BOOK CORRECTION

We have collected the students' notebook from the parents for correction at five fixed points. The teachers have corrected the notebooks and sent it back on time. This process has been done twice a month. The books that we collect on Monday, will be returned to the parents on Thursday and similarly, the books that we get from the parents on Thursday, will be returned to them on following Monday.

DESCRIPTIVE TEST

A descriptive test was conducted in all subjects for the students of classes VI and VII. We have received the question papers from MVM Chetpet, Chennai. As per the timetable shared by our main school, we sent across the question papers to the parents and requested them to administrate the test at home under their supervision. Once the tests are completed test notebooks will be collected from them for evaluation.

REPORT CARDS

Report card is an all-in-one student and class management system. To establish the level of knowledge of each and every student, we created E-report cards and shared with the parents in their private WhatsApp number.



PARENTS TEACHER MEETING

Parents Teachers' Meeting of classes Pre KG to II was held on 24th August 2020 (Monday) at 2.30 p.m. through Microsoft Team App online. Similarly meeting for classes III to VII was held on 26th August 2020 (Wednesday) at 2.30 p.m. The parents got an opportunity to interact with the teachers handling the classes online. The parents shared their views and concerns on academic related work done by the school. The interaction helped the school to take further steps to improve the quality of learning experience provided online. There was also another round of PTM in the month of September to discuss the online classes. The principal listened to the parents' concerns and answered their queries.





RAKSHA BANDHAN






Education is the key to success in life, and teachers make a lasting impact in the lives of their students.
