Subsequent to the successful completion of inspection, our school was granted affiliation to the CBSE.



ONLINE CLASSES

Online learning has emerged as a convenient option at these difficult times. Having observed the active involvement of students and their improved performance we have increased the number of online sessions for Grade LKG to Grade VIII from June. Online classes for KG students are taken regularly from Monday to Friday. We have MS Teams app with improved features to engage the students meaningfully in online learning.







Printed Worksheets

In order to provide a unique learning avenue to the students, our school has issued printed worksheets for all subjects for the months of June & July. This enables the students to monitor the progress of their own learning.

Distribution of textbooks & notebooks

We have issued books and notebooks to the students for the academic year 2021-2022 for all the classes from LKG-VIII. We have also tabulated and shared the subject wise notebooks segregation list to help the children start using them accordingly.

MVM Parents WhatsApp group

A new WhatsApp group (MVM Parents) has been created for students and parents of all grades (LKG-VIII) which can be used by the students to send the work done by them and get their doubts clarified by the teachers.









An online interactive session with parents (PTM) was conducted on 26th June 2021 at 2.00 pm through Microsoft team's app for grade LKG- VIII with the aim of getting feedback about the online classes and worksheets sent by our teachers. The interactions helped us improve the quality of work that we do and the methods adopted so far.

School website

We have launched our revamped school website www.mvmpondy.com on 10^{th} June, 2021 which gives regular updates on school facilities, resources available and activities organized in the school

Online Test

Online test - I was conducted for Grade I- Grade VIII to test the subject knowledge of the students after making them try an online model exam. Online test link was sent to the WhatsApp group along with the test timing.







Online question papers for all subjects were designed for:

20 marks -- Grade I & II

25 marks - Grade III -V

50 marks - Grade V-VIII

Almost all the students participated in the online test. Report cards of all students were updated and shared through our MVM School Mobile App.

Open Book Assessment-1

An Open Book Assessment-1 for grade I to V commenced on 14.07.2021. This was based on the concepts taught to the children and included Value based questions. We have shared exam timetable, portions & blueprint for all the subjects. Question papers were sent through the WhatsApp group as well as uploaded in our school app on the day of the exam according to the timetable. The students wrote the answers in their respective test notes and submitted the same for correction on the given date.

Monthly Assessment-1

Monthly Assessment-1 was carried out for the middle school students (Grade VI- VIII) to test their understanding. We have received the question papers from Chetpet, Chennai. The question papers were sent through WhatsApp group as well as uploaded in our school app on the particular day of exam according to the timetable. The students wrote the answers in their respective test notes and submitted the same for correction on the mentioned date.









It has been observed that some students attend the online classes intently and a few of them were regular and sincere in completing the given tasks. In order to appreciate their consistent attendance in the online classes, we have sent **E-certificates** to the students who have attended all online classes in the months of June & July.

Posting Students' video on our school Facebook page

Our school's Facebook page has a section to commemorate special events and days. We have decided to give opportunity to the students by posting their video presentations based on the content given by our teachers. we started this with grade VIII students.

Notebooks collection

We have decided to collect the notebooks and completed worksheets from the students for correction during the second and fourth week of every month. On 27th July, we collected the notebooks of the students (LKG-VIII) as per the location and time mentioned before. We returned the notebooks to the students on 30.07.2021 after correcting them.
